Dr. Tal Rotman is a Senior Partner at one of Israel's leading law firms, and a Psychology Ph.D. Student at Reichman University, where he studies the effects of psychedelics on the human brain at Prof. Amir Amedi's lab in the Baruch Ivcher Institute for Brain, Cognition & Technology and the Ruth and Meir Rosental Brain Imaging Center.
