INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE PREPARATION OF ABSTRACTS FOR POSTERS

- Only registered participants will be able to present posters at the conference
- Posters will be presented in person at thematically organized poster sessions.
- Posters will be available for viewing the whole day of the poster session in which they are included.

All submitted abstracts will be reviewed for acceptance based on scientific merit.

Abstracts must be submitted via the online form only (see Technical Instructions below).

All abstracts must be submitted in English, and should be no longer than 400 words (not including the title, author names and affiliations).

The name and affiliations of the author(s) should be included in the abstract, i.e. department, institution, city, country.

If submitting more than one abstract, each abstract must be submitted separately.

The submitter should attest that they have agreed to participate and are aware that they will need to pay the conference registration fee and their travel and hotel costs.

Please note that the final inclusion of the accepted abstract in the scientific program is dependent on payment of registration fees by the presenter at least two months prior to the conference.

Abstract submissions should be structured with the following:

- Background
- Aims & Objectives
- Method
- Results
- Discussion & Conclusion
